This document explains how to enable SMTP Authentication for Outlook XP (also known as Outlook 2002), and Outlook 2003.

- 1. Open Outlook.
- 2. From the Tools menu, select Email Accounts
- 3. Verify that the circle-box View or change existing email accounts is selected and click Next.
- 4. Click on your email account, and click the Change button on the right.
- 5. Under the Server Information section, in the box marked Outgoing mail server (SMTP), change it to mail.velocitynet.com.au
- 6. Click the button More Settings... in the lower right-hand corner.
- 7. Click the Outgoing Server tab.
- 8. Click the circle-box "My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication", and verify that the circle-box "Use same settings as my incoming mail server" is selected.
- 9. Click OK to close the Internet Email Settings box.
- 10. IMPORTANT: Do NOT use the "Test Account Setting..." button to test the settings. This will fail.
- 11. Click the Finish button to close the Email Accounts box.

SMTP authentication has now been enabled.
